

Cabin Filter Replacement

If you have a 2017 or newer model, did you know your dash A/C unit has a cabin air filter? This is one of those out of sight, out of mind items that should be checked and/or changed at least every couple of years.

The location of the filter is not obvious and you have to know where it is to find it. On the coaches with a Power Glide chassis, the Denso air unit is in the middle of the front “firewall” above the generator. In the case of ours, it was partially hidden behind one of the flexible ducts and partially covered with spray foam. On some other models it’s located on the passenger side under the front hood.

The cover over the filter has a couple of locking tabs at the top and bottom. Squeeze those inward and the cover just pulls off. The filter is tucked inside and easily pulls out.

A new filter can be ordered from Tiffin or RVPartsmasters for about \$31, but there is a cross reference to Fram Filter #CF10285 available on Amazon for less than \$20. That filter is listed for a Toyota, but the dimensions are exactly the same as the Denso unit.
